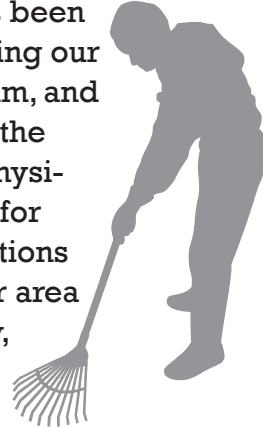

## Welcome to the ESA Trivia Night

Would you like to see what you might know? Do you like to get together with friends and family for a night of doing something different? If so, mark your calendar and get your team together for the EAGLE SCOUT ASSOCIATION TRIVIA NIGHT!

### Here's How it Works

You simply gather as a group of eight friends and/or relatives. Tables can be comprised of couples, singles or a combination. Each table brings their own appetizers, snacks and BYOB (for adults), the ESA will provide the soft drinks.

At the event, one person from each table will be the "scribe". As the trivia questions are read, your table will act as a team to collectively come up with the answer and whisper it to the scribe who then writes down the table's answers.

There will be ten rounds of questions. Each round will have questions from a specific category, i.e. sports, movies, music, presidents etc. (not necessarily those categories.) After each round is over, the answer sheets are collected and the next round starts, with few other games in between. The answer sheets are scored by ESA workers. Each right answer receives one point. The score standings are posted, so that you can see how well your table is doing.

There will be prizes for the winners, and a raffle for other great items as well. And, whether your team wins or not, just have a great time!
