### Procedures

The Eagle Scout applying for a scholarship must:

- Personally complete the entire application.
- All applications must be printed or typed.
- Enclose only the items identified in the requirements below (no biographies, résumés, or supplementary lists of activities).
- Attach no more than eight pages to the application.
- Include the applicant's name on the bottom of each page of the application and on each attachment the applicant's name and address.
- Submit the application with all attachments to the Eagle Scout Association of Greater St. Louis, Inc. (Eagle Scout Association (ESA)):

- The ESA will not assume responsibility for matching items received separately and will not be responsible for lost or misdirected application.
- Applications become the property of the ESA and will not be returned.
- On an annual basis the ESA Scholarship Committee will choose the number and nature of the scholarships being awarded. Currently the organization supports two different scholarships:
  1. Life Member Scholarship – awarded to a life member of the Eagle Scout Association
  2. Member Scholarships awarded to a regular or annual Eagle Scout Association member.
- The committee will, in writing, notify those selected of its decision. There is no appeal and all decisions of the committee are final.
- The list of those selected to receive a scholarship will be posted on the ESA website ([www.stlesa.org](http://www.stlesa.org)).
- Understand that submitting this application is in no way a guarantee that a scholarship will be granted.

### Requirements

All applicants must

1. Be an Eagle Scout and provide copies of credentials from the national office.
2. Provide transcripts of high school or college grades covering six most recent semesters. The transcript need not be "official"; a legible photocopy is acceptable.
3. Have demonstrated leadership ability in Scouting and a strong record of participation in activities outside of Scouting.
4. Applications must be postmarked prior to 1 March, 2012 and received prior to 15 March, 2012 for consideration.

## Scholarships Based on Demonstrated Leadership

This application is for scholarships that are provided through the Eagle Scout Association of Greater St. Louis, Inc. (Eagle Scout Association (ESA)). The following conditions must be accepted and met by the scholarship recipient in order to receive the scholarship disbursement:

1. Register and maintain status as a full-time student, during the life of the scholarship (one year), at a college/university of your choosing. (Work co-op programs are not an acceptable means of meeting full-time-student status.)
2. Select a college/university which is:
  - a. accredited by a recognized accreditation agency
  - b. offering a degree upon completion of the course of study
3. Provide verification of your student status to the ESA. Verification can be but is not limited to: copies of enrollment documentation, course schedule, or school financial receipts.
4. Submit an itemized invoice for tuition, room, board or books to the ESA. All funds are paid directly to you by ESA upon receipt of an itemized invoice in a single (one-time) payment.

### The Eagle Scout Association of Greater St. Louis, Inc.

The Eagle Scout Association (ESA) was founded by Eagle Scouts of the St. Louis Boy Scout Council and is the oldest organization of its kind in the nation. Chartered in 1947, the ESA's membership consists of Eagle Scouts of all ages who want to give back to Scouting some of what they received from Scouting. Membership is open to any Eagle Scout who is at least eighteen years of age and has completed and submitted a membership application to the association.

The ESA is very active in upgrading and improving our council's Scout camps. Projects range from physical improvement and repairs to major construction projects.

The Eagle Scout Association produces Merit Badge Make-Up Day at Beaumont Scout Reservation. This event allows Scouts to complete those last few requirements on merit badges they began at summer camp but were unable to finish at camp.

The ESA also conducts the annual Golf Tournament and Trivia Night. These events help raise the needed funds to support our special projects and scholarship program – and it's a fun day for the ESA members as well.

Many ESA members are active in supporting Scouting at the council, district and unit levels. ESA members volunteer their time as unit leaders, committee members, commissioners and in other district, council, regional and national positions.

While many of our members may belong to the National Eagle Scout Association (NESA), there is no affiliation or connection between the Eagle Scout Association of Greater St. Louis, Inc. and NESA.
